### Introduction-










### Blank North Indian Horoscope




Your chart is divided into 12 houses, each representing different life areas such as identity, finances, relationships, and career. The 12 zodiac signs, from Aries to Pisces, influence these houses with their unique energies and characteristics. Together, the interplay of planets, houses, and signs offers insights into an individual's personality, life events, and potential future, serving as a guide for self-reflection and personal growth.



# Original Position of the Zodiac

These positions change with time and location. Take note that each sign has a number associated with it. These numbers represent the sign and do not change.




### 12 Houses of the Zodiac

This is how your horoscope is divided if you look up at the sky from where you are standing.

These houses stay the same, while the planets and the zodiac signs move with time.

# Putting it Together






This is what your horoscope looks like when you start to add planets.


Because the numbers represent zodiac gigns, you can read this as a Taurus Ascendent/Rising sign with a Cancer Moon and an Aquarius Sun






### WTF is an Ascendant?

In Vedic astrology, the Ascendant, or "Lagna," is the zodiac sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. It is crucial for setting up the birth chart, as it determines the starting point for the 12 astrological houses. While the houses themselves remain fixed in their order, the Ascendant dictates which zodiac signs occupy each house. This setup affects how different aspects of life, like personality, relationships, and career, are influenced by the characteristics of the signs that align with each house.



## Will everyone born on the same day have



#### No!

People born on the same day can have different horoscopes because the exact time and location of birth affect the Ascendant and the positions of the planets in the houses. The Ascendant changes approximately every two hours, altering the alignment of zodiac signs with the houses. Additionally, the precise positions of the Moon and other fast-moving planets can vary throughout the day. These differences lead to unique birth charts, resulting in distinct horoscopes for individuals born on the same day.
